SITE-SPECIFIC SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT No. 002  
TO  
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
THE STATE OF ARIZONA, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY  
(DPS Contract No. 2002-080, AG Contract No. KR2-0579TRN)  
AND  
THE CITY OF PHOENIX, INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT  
(Agreement No. 98439)

ADPS Site: White Tank Mountains

Pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement between Arizona Department of Public Safety and City of Phoenix entered into on June 3, 2002 the parties enter into this supplemental agreement. All provisions of the June 3, 2002 IGA are incorporated into this supplemental agreement.

The host agency is Arizona Department of Public Safety (ADPS) and the benefiting agencies are both ADPS and the City of Phoenix.

ADPS will provide ten (10) 700 MHz frequency pairs and funding not to exceed \$800,000 to cover the cost to purchase and install a new remote trunk site at White Tank Mountains and system interfaces between the Phoenix Regional Wireless Network (PRWN) and the Yuma Regional Communications System (YRCS).

The City of Phoenix or their designated contractor shall install a new, ten-channel, 700 MHz remote trunk site at the existing ADPS facility on the White Tank Mountains.

The City of Phoenix or their designated contractor shall install new ADPS and YRCS console and system interface equipment at a designated ADPS facility.

ADPS will provide sufficient floor and tower space, power, backup power, and T1 connectivity from White Tank Mountains to a co-located ADPS/City of Phoenix facility.

The City of Phoenix agrees to connect the new remote site on White Tank Mountains to PRWN, and agrees to share the use of PRWN sites, including this new site, with ADPS. This site sharing and transfer of frequencies and funds is in consideration for the shared use of PRWN with ADPS. Shared use of PRWN shall not exceed six hundred (600) State Agency subscribers and seven (7) State Agency talkgroups.

The City of Phoenix and ADPS agree to modify or supersede this agreement with a new agreement under the authority and terms of a new governance body designated to represent PRWN.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties herein have caused this Agreement to be executed in triplicate originals.
